2. Activities in the last month since last report:
 - a. The tokens for the Token project have been received. Posters and tent cards for participating businesses are being produced. The scheme is due to launch on 25th May 2018.
 - b. A public workshop to sensitise residents on the issues around those living on the street will be held at the Community Centre on 26th May. Facebook, the OCA members list and websites will be used to advertise this event. It is a morning only event.
 - c. There have been a number of new street people making Observatory their home recently, and there have been a number of residents complaining about the activities of street people. These issues are being discussed with OBSID.

Liquour Licence Applications Sub-Committee Report to OCA Management Committee April 2018

2. The application for liquor licence for Forneria Italia has been approved by the sub-committee.
3. There have been no other applications to date.

 - Obtain an up to date list of all valid licences for Observatory to date, as well as a list of any applications in progress.

6. The sub-committee understands that Observatory involvement in the Woodstock CPF may be resurrected, and if so this sub-committee will work more closely with this body, and consequently with Woodstock SAPS.
