Daniela Ciaffi is an architect and community planner. She is an Associate Professor of Urban Sociology at the Politecnico di Torino, Department of Territorial Studies and Planning.

Over 200 Italian municipalities have approved local government regulations to foster collaboration between communities and the City for the regeneration of urban commons.

This kind of regulations is uniquely Italian, inspired by the paradigm of a "shared administration". A model based on the recognition that people have not only needs but also capabilities that can enable communities to find solutions to problems of common interest.
