## REAL411. KEEPING IT REAL IN DIGITAL MEDIA.

Following the success of the Real411 in the elections it was clear that we needed to set up a system that would enable members of the public to report disinformation and ensure it was addressed in an open, transparent and accountable manner within our laws and constitutional principles.

We also found that during the lead up to the elections people weren't just wanting to report disinformation but also cases of incitement and hate speech. We have decided to add those to the new version of Real411.

### Do you want to report a digital offence?

You can report 4 types of digital offences on Real 411 namely, Disinformation, hate speech, incitement to violence and journalist harassment. Disinformation is false, inaccurate or misleading information designed, presented and promoted online to intentionally cause public harm. Hate speech suggests messages with malicious intent to harm or dehumanise and may lead to incitement of violence. Incitement is the encouragement of others to commit a crime, in this case violent

actions, which may cause harm, damage or even death. Journalists can report unwanted conduct that is persistent or serious and demeans, humiliates or creates a hostile or intimidating environment to induce submission by actual or threatened adverse consequences. Read more...

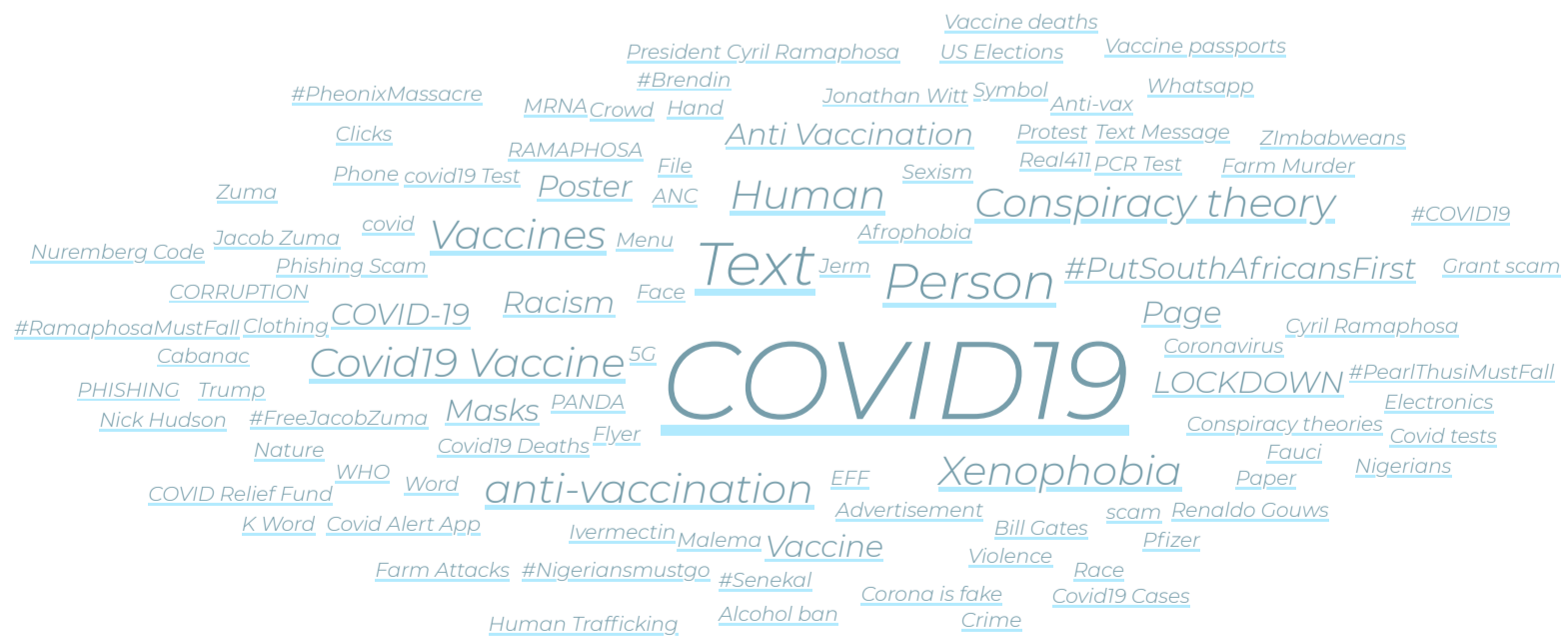
