The City of Cape Town is in the process of revising the Urban Forest Policy (previously called "Tree Management Policy").

This policy for the management of trees will be clustered around four key components:

- a. Promote sustainable new tree planting suitable for location and requirements
- b. Ensure the sustainable management of current trees
- c. Reinforce the importance and value of trees (ecological, social, economic)
- d. Encourage adequate tree management on private land

The policy proposes managing the entire Urban Forest in a holistic manner. An Urban Forest is the sum of all trees growing within the boundaries of the city.

In terms of section 17 of the Local Government: Municipal Systems Act, Act 32 of 2000, the public and interested parties or groups are given the opportunity to submit comments, recommendations or input to the City from 1 to 30 April 2022.
